RVDOG Halloween Party Reinstated, Reinterpreted To Encompass Election Day: Halloection Day

Getuplicans and Getdownocrats Join Together in Rare Bipartasin Endorsement of Tha Shizzle

PLANO, TX, OCTOBER 11, 2004, AP: RSVDog Entertainment (formerly RVDog Entertainment) announced today that after a two-year hiatus, the RSVDog Halloween Party will once again be held in 2004, starting at 9 p.m. on November 6, at their global entertainment complex in Plano, Texas.

"We are quite proud of the fact that both the Getuplicans and the Getdownocrats support this party, which we fully intend to be a nonpartisan event. We at RSVD do not endorse candidates or issue positions on any controversial topics. We are completely impartial," he continued.

Guests are invited to wear costumes and to be prepared to Get Down Wit Dey Bad Selfs. Refreshments, food, and music will be provided. Guests are encouraged to bring additional refreshments and food of all varieties to share.

"We are working to build a rainbow coalition of refreshments," said Vince Cavasin, RSVD CRO (Chief Refreshment Officer). "During its 10-year run, the RVDog party attained a reputation as a

veritable Refreshments Petri Dish; there's hardly a party refreshment in existence that wasn't served at one of those parties. One year, we even served something that made these women look attractive."

"The time around Halloween is traditionally known as the festival of the Party God Zoltar," says Urquhart, adopting a tone of reverence. "It is not commonly known that Zoltar was also the god of elections, so this is a special year spiritually for us at RSVDog Entertainment."

"This party is both a chance to, if you will, 'get Bizzy Wit Tha Nizzy', and to pay your respects to the mythological figure to whom we owe our greatest gifts as a society: the right to vote and the right to G-G-G-Get Up and Get-Get Doooooooooooooon!"

The hosts also request that given the solemn nature of this event, all guests be at least of voting age.
